

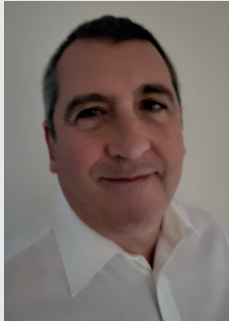

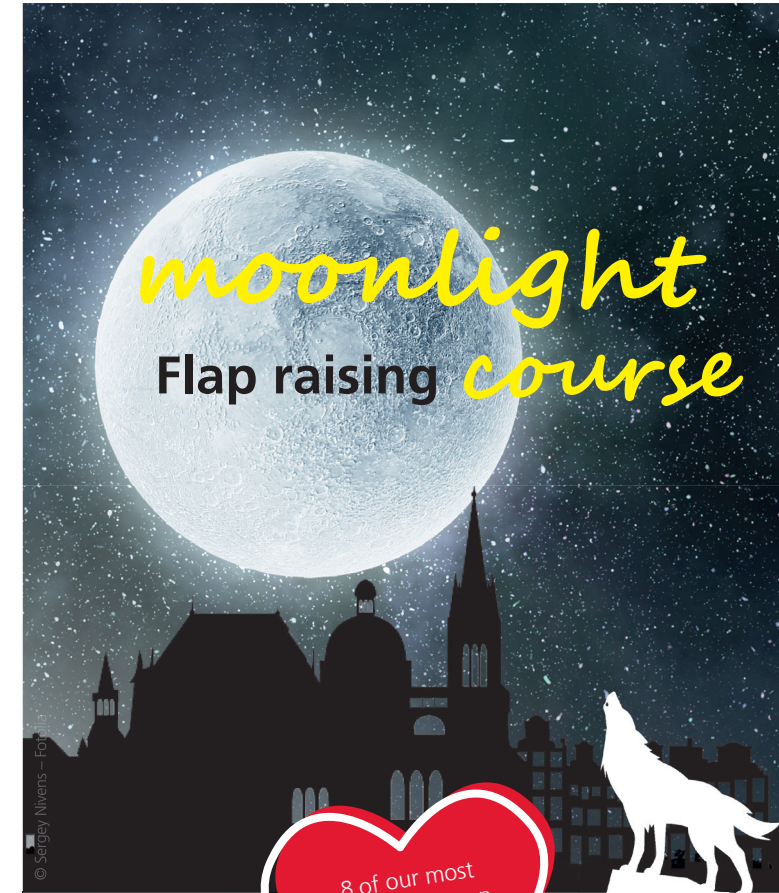

## Aim

The focus of this course lies with practical exercise under simulated extreme circumstances. The aim is that beginners learn straight forward flap raising of the most important flaps in head and neck surgery and advanced surgeons can enlarge their technical scope. The course is therefore designed for surgeons of various levels of experience to test their skills in a safe but demanding set of scenarios. **This unique course will allow clinical practice of emergency flap substitution during a 24 hour continuous day and night simulated flap raising exercise.** Participants should be aware of the physical and mental demands this unique experience will place on them and understand this will provide a very different experience from our usual flap raising courses.

## Program

- » Personal step by step raising of the most important flaps for head and neck reconstruction in cadavers
- » Conditions for flap raising and dissection will be similar to those of the living human body due to embalming technique according to Thiel
- » Indications and examples for surgical applications are demonstrated
- » The advantages and disadvantages of various free flaps are discussed
- » The physical and mental demands of returning to the operating room after a full day of surgery and interruption of normal daily life will be simulated during this unique flap raising course
